The Feliz Ranch and Vineyard exemplifies all the qualities that make for a premier vineyard and hunting ranch. Located just an hour and half from the Golden Gate Bridge and situated just 2 minutes outside of the wine and food village of Hopland and only about 10 minutes from Sonoma County. The ranch consists of 420 acres. Right off the county paved road you access the ranch's internal road network which winds you through 90 acres of planted vineyard.

The ranch is bordered by Duncan Creek to the west and two winery estates to the east, Saracina and Jeriko Estate. Vineyard varietals on the ranch include Cabernet Sauvignon, Pinot Noir, Sangiovese, Dolcetto, Barbera, Chardonnay, Syrah, Sauvignon Blanc, & Zinfandel. There are an additional 50 acres of ground suitable for vineyard expansion that was historically in production. The water resource consists of 4 reservoirs perched in the hills beyond to the north and west of the vineyard. One of the many great attributes of the ranch is its wide spectrum terroir, allowing for white varietals and red varietals to achieve intense wine grape flavors.

There are great building sites throughout the ranch that give a variety of viewscape, vineyard, and mountain vistas. Whether you prefer a cabin style residence with a reservoir/vineyard or a trophy estate residence there are plenty of amazing site options awaiting your grand imagination.

In the hills beyond the vineyard, you will find oak woodlands, rollings grassy glades, and plenty of wildlife habitat for the outdoor sportsman. Southern Mendocino County, and Hopland specifically, is known for trophy blacktail deer and wild pigs. Some of the largest wild pigs from California come from this area and Mendocino County has the most entries for B&C blacktail deer.

Ranch infrastructure includes a modest home and ranch equipment barn. There is power at the property line. The Feliz ranch presents an excellent opportunity to create that legacy vineyard and ranch opportunity you've been waiting for.



Mendocino is a rural county of striking natural beauty, friendly small towns and people who love and protect the land. Since the 1850s, Mendocino County has developed a personality


