Feliz Vineyards is a 420-acre parcel zoned RL (min. 160 acres) that exemplifies all of the qualities that make for a premier vineyard, cannabis development, or estate ranch. It is located just an hour and a half from due north of the Golden Gate Bridge, 2 miles west of Highway 101, 3 minutes outside of Hopland's wine and food village, and about 10 minutes from the Sonoma County line.

Vineyard varietals on the ranch include Cabernet Sauvignon, Pinot Noir, Sangiovese, Dolcetto, Barbera, Chardonnay, Syrah, Sauvignon Blanc, & Zinfandel. There are an additional 50 acres of ground suitable for vineyard expansion that was historically in production. The water resource consists of 4 reservoirs perched in the hills to the northwest used for irrigation and frost protection, riparian water rights from Feliz Creek, and a 12+/- gallon per minute well. One of the many great attributes of the ranch is its wide spectrum terroir, allowing for white varietals and red varietals to achieve intense wine

grape flavors. The owner may sign a grape purchase agreement. There are great building sites throughout the ranch that give various view scapes, vineyard, and mountain vistas. Whether you prefer a cabin-style residence with a reservoir/ vineyard or a trophy estate residence, there are plenty of amazing site options awaiting your grand imagination. You will find oak woodlands, rolling grassy glades in the hills beyond the vineyard, and plenty of wildlife habitat for the outdoor sportsman. Southern Mendocino County, and Hopland specifically, is known for trophy blacktail deer and wild pigs. Ranch infrastructure includes a modest home and ranch equipment barn. There is power at the property line. The Feliz ranch presents an excellent opportunity to create that legacy vineyard and ranch opportunity you've been waiting for.

MENDOCINO COUNTY WINE MAP




Mendocino is a rural county of striking natural beauty, friendly small towns and people who love and protect the land. Since the 1850s, Mendocino County has developed a personality
