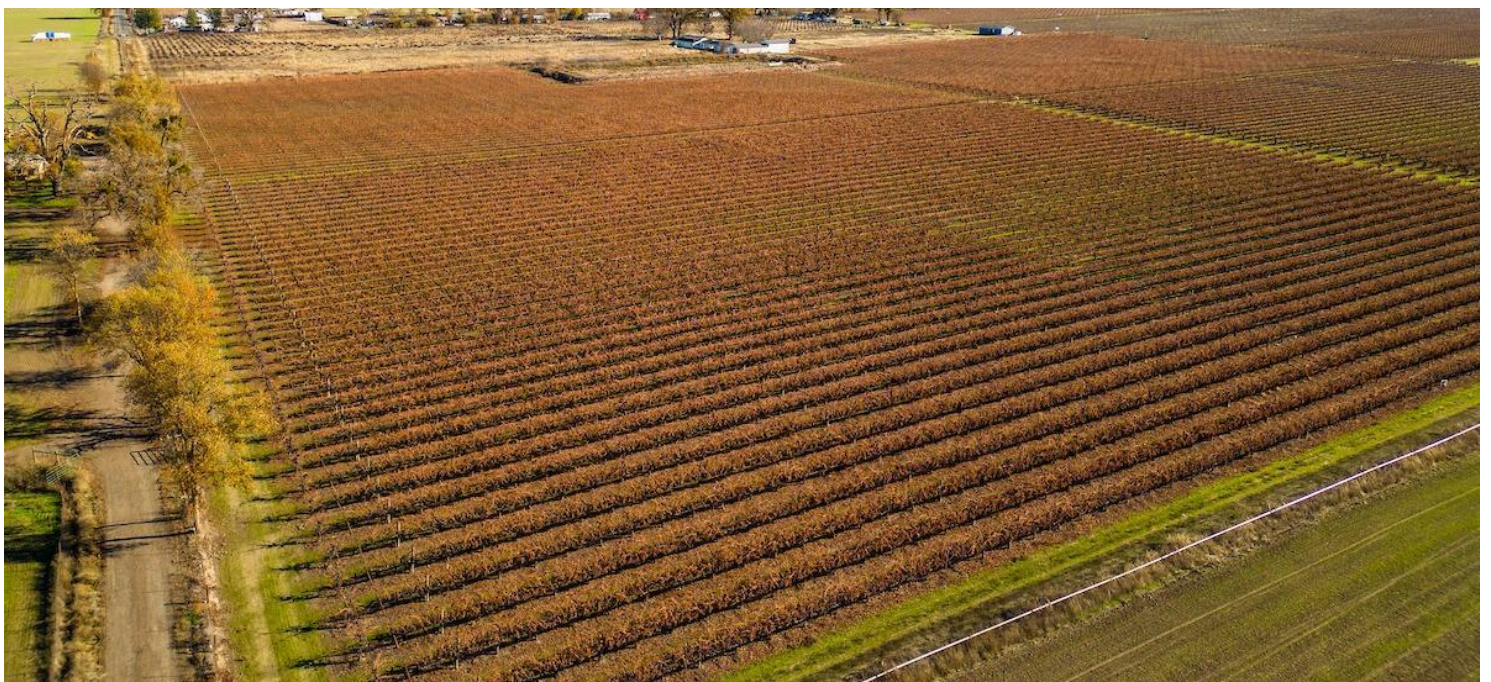
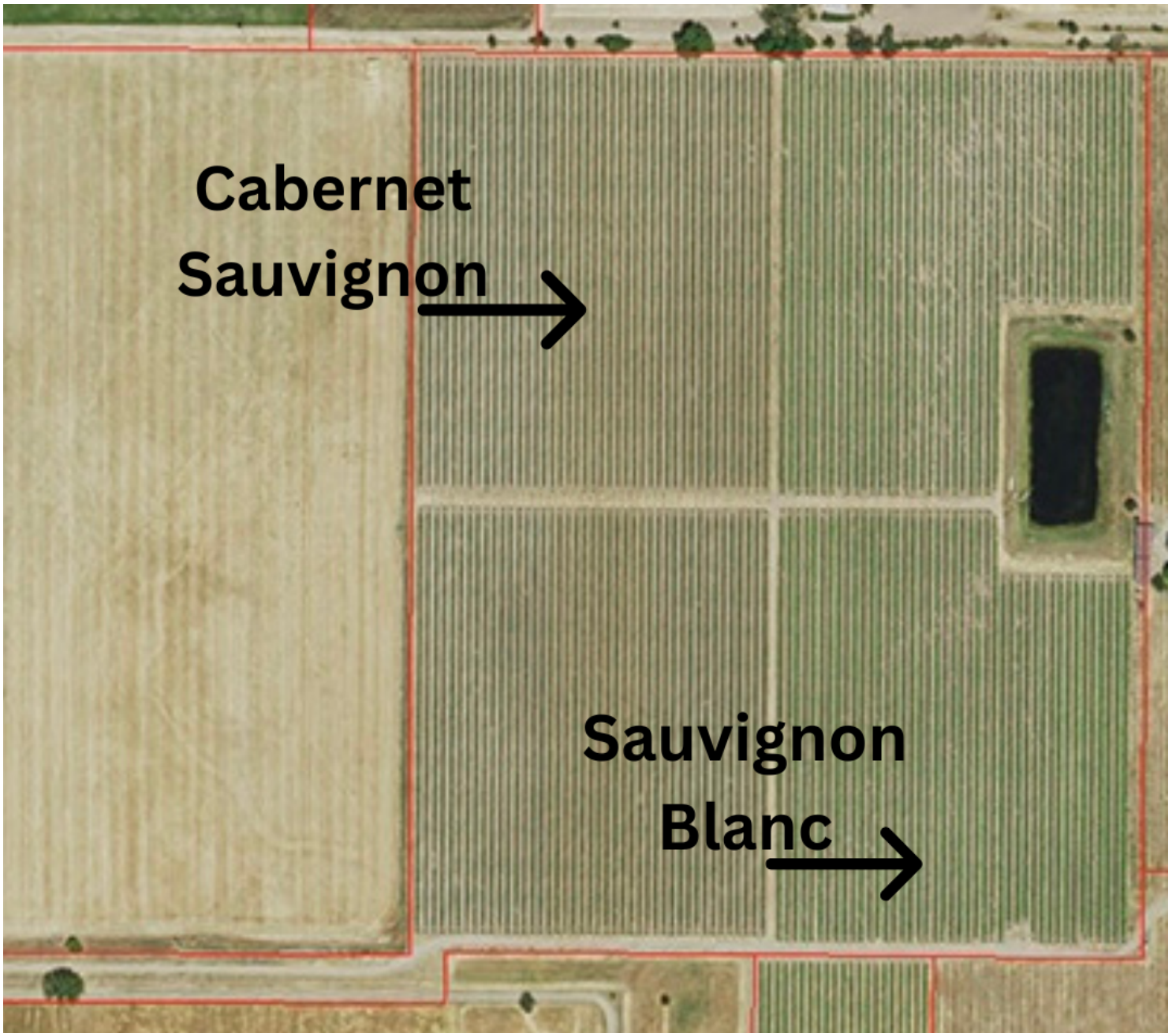

The property benefits from an abundant water supply, featuring a 450+ GPM AG well and an on-site reservoir, ensuring optimal irrigation for the vineyard. The vineyard is professionally managed by the esteemed Bella Vista Farming, known for their expertise in maximizing grape quality and yield. The majority of the vineyard features a well-designed quad trellis system, with some areas utilizing bi-lateral trellising, showcasing the thoughtful and efficient layout of the vineyard. This is a rare opportunity to own a thriving vineyard in a sought-after AVA, with the potential to continue its legacy of high-quality grape production. COMPONENTS OF VALUE

- 33 acres total land, with 28.5 in production.
- 13.5 acres of Sauvignon Blanc
- 15 acres of Cabernet Sauvignon. Planted by Don Eutenier in 1999, and professionally maintained by Bella Vista Farming since 2011.
- SB is under contract with Foley Family Wines and Allied Grape Growers through the 2024 growing season. In 2023, Foley paid \$1,500 per ton.
- Rootstock: 5BB
- Clones: CS includes clones 7 and 8, SB unknown
- Trellis Quad-lateral predominates with some bi-lateral
- Irrigation: drip irrigation installed with overhead sprinkler for frost protection
- Spacing: rows are 8 feet apart, vines are 10 feet
- Well: 450 gpm+
- Natural gas pump for frost irrigation from the reservoir
- Soil type: Still Loam, Stratified Substratum, well drained soil
- Production Average since 2011: SB 70 tons, CS 83 tons
